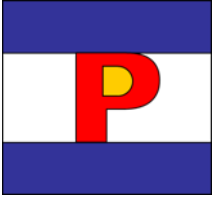

One thing I wanted to bring back to our club is the 'On The Trail' program. **On The Trail** program rewards riders for spending time with their best friend, their Pinto horse. Time can be spent trail riding, driving, participating in parades, drill teams, therapeutic riding, riding lessons, or any other **non-competitive** activity. You may earn DOUBLE hours for time spent riding in national and state parks, grasslands or historic areas as recognized the US National Parks Service.

To get started, go to www.PtHA.org, PROGRAMS>On The Trail. Print out an enrollment form, fill it out and send it in with the one-time enrollment fee of \$35.00. Don't forget to download the **On The Trail Time Log Form** to help you keep track of hours. You must be a National member of PtHA in order for your hours to count and Yes, your horse must be registered with PtHA. Solid Pintos are allowed. You do NOT have to own the Pinto that you participate on. Certificates, patches and/or awards are earned by those who make milestone achievements in this program.

If you have a horse, colored or solid, you would like to have registered as a Pinto, please contact me, Diane Chartier at dianec2010@hotmail.com. DISCIPLINE RAIL: This class is to show the ability of a highly trained horse. Judged on overall performance, manners and conformation. The class routine shall be performed on the rail and may include, but is not limited to:

- A short walk, jog/trot or slow lope/canter
- A hand gallop (no more than 8 at one time)
- Simple or Flying lead changes
- Starting a lope/canter from a halt
- Starting/traveling on the counter lope/canter
- Side passes/leg yields
- Forehand or hindquarter turn
- Square stop, Stand quietly

** Prize money will be awarded: 1st \$75.00, 2nd \$50.00, 3rd \$25.00

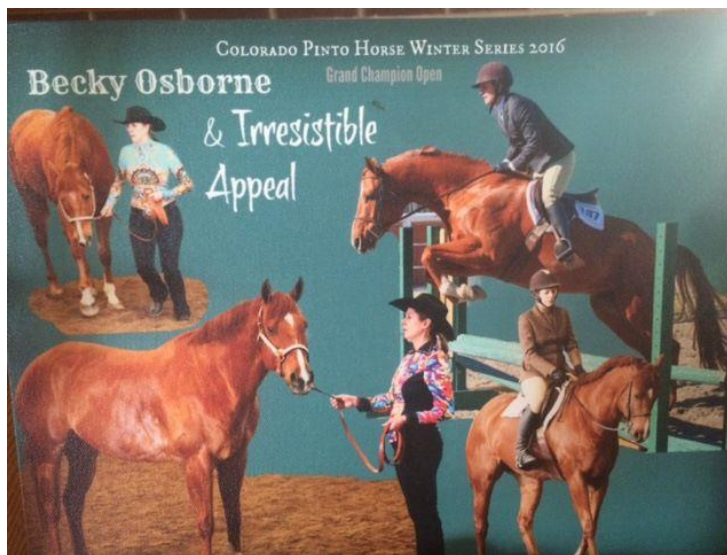
