## Colorado Pinto Horse Association Rules

1. Open to all breeds, ages and disciplines.
2. **Professionals** are welcome to enter in **Open and training tack classes**.
3. Shows are judged using PtHA rules
4. Required Apparel: Boots, long-sleeved shirts, Western hat or hunt cap required except where allowed by PtHA rules. Hunt cap need not be ASTM approved. Chaps optional; hunt coat optional.
5. **Membership must be paid before points accrue.**
6. **NOVICE RIDER** is anyone who is in the first TWO years of showing. Novice Riders may only enter Novice Division classes, open classes and classes which do not count for daily or year-end high point awards.
7. Open Classes are open to all exhibitors, including youth, adults and professionals.
8. Showmanship and Trail Classes may be shown in English or Western attire and tack. This designation must be made at time of entry. **If no designation is made on your Registration Form, your points will be counted toward Western daily high point .**
9. Show manager reserves the right to split, combine, or cancel any classes.
10. Stallions may not be shown by any person under the age of 18 years.
11. No strollers or loose dogs allowed for the safety of those riding.
12. Lead line riders pay no office charge when horse is registered with another rider in other classes on show day.
13. **WALK/TROT CLASSES:** Same Horse/Rider combination may not enter into any class that includes canter or lope. In Equitation and Horsemanship classes riders may be asked to execute a pattern.
14. **DAILY HIGH POINT and AWARDS:** Points will be earned equal to the number of entries in the class (up to 6 entries) with 1<sup>st</sup> place earning the greatest number of points. COPtHA Membership is not required for Daily Awards. Each class will be awarded Pinto Bucks for 1st through 6th place. Pinto bucks may be redeemed for ribbons or prizes from the prize table. Daily high point awards will be given for English and Western in each division. Daily Overall Hi point will be given for W/Trot, In-hand Mini and Driving. (Halter is not counted into daily high point tabulation.)
15. **YEAR-END HIGH POINT AWARDS:** Walk/Trot (youth and adult), Novice, 18 & Under, 19 & Over and Open receive year end awards for 1st through 5th place. Leadline riders will receive year-end awards for participation if they show in at least 3 shows. After the third show of the season, show management will determine if any age group will be split for purposes of year end awards into a Junior and Senior division. Halter Year End awards are given to the highest placing horses in each of Mares and Stallions/Geldings. Overall High Point award will be given to In-hand Miniature horse and Driving.
16. **Year End Award Eligibility:** In order to be eligible for year-end awards, the same exhibitor/horse combination must have shown in at least three shows and be a COPtHA Member. **Points accumulate AFTER membership payment is received.** In addition, an exhibitor must have shown in at least 3 different classes in a Division in order to be eligible for year-end awards in that Division.
